

The Forgotten by David Baldacci

John Puller, Army Special Agent goes to Paradise, Florida to check on his elderly Aunt after his father receives a rather cryptic letter from her. On his arrival in Florida John is shocked to learn that his Aunt is dead as a result of an accident, according to the local authorities. John is skeptical about that verdict and starts doing his own investigating into his Aunt's death, which he concludes was murder and not an accident. In the meantime another character by the name of Mecho arrives in Florida trying to locate his sister who was taken by human traffickers. He knows the name of the person who is behind the trafficking, but the man lives in a fortress in Paradise and has armed guards protecting his property. Mecho manages to get on a landscape crew on the man's property and as they say starts casing the joint.

Eventually John and Mecho cross paths and find out that the death of John's Aunt and the kidnapping of Mecho's sister are connected in a remote sort of way. They team up near the end of the book along with an Army General friend of John's and a Columbian undercover cop who has been staying on the estate of the man who is behind the human trafficking operation and proceed to go after the bad guys.
